Scandinavian Airlift

Estonia

A historic event took place in Tallinn, Estonia, on Saturday, 4th April. Pastors of various churches said that this Prophetic Conference in the National Concert Hall, sponsored by FGBMFI, Finland, represented a spiritual breakthrough for the nation. The 600 plus people attending listened to short addresses by many of Estonia's pastors from various Christian denominations. There were two speakers from the FGBMFI with Finnish National FGBMFI President, Jukka Koski, giving the final talk. When a call for prayer was given more than 100 people crowded the front to receive individual ministry. That evening there was an information event where details about our work were related. Here among others, Swedish FGBMFI National President, Alf Liljehall shared. Throughout the weekend much interest was shown for our vision.

Latvia

Leaders of FGBMFI Latvia met with an international team in Riga on Thursday, 2nd April. The Latvian men shared how they are now meeting weekly with two groups. The visiting men prayed for the Latvian leaders and the Lord did a deep work.

Finland

Sweden

Newly elected FGBMFI National President, Alf Liljehall hosted a visiting international team, including Ron and Peggy Graham from Spokane, Washington, Wayne and Evelyn Scott from Vancouver, BC, Canada, and Blair Scott, International Publications Director. A wonderful power of the Holy Spirit was present throughout their visit. At the Swedish National Convention a new National Council was prayed over on the final evening, 28th March. They have new vision for the Swedish Voice magazine, which is planned in the style of the new French Voix. The belief is that God is doing a new thing and they are ready to see great things happen in Sweden.

During the airlift of the above-mentioned group to Scandinavia amazing things took place, summed up in the words of one couple in Finland who tearfully told the group on their departure, "This has changed our marriage and lives. It would have been more than worth it had you come for us alone." John Hermanson from Michigan, who has worked for many years with FGBMFI Finland, and a number of Finns also joined the airlift for the Baltic States outreaches.



Finland

On the ship returning to Finland the team remarked that they had prayed for so many people that there would have been no time to minister to more. Although there were moments of challenge and spiritual battles, such as when three of the group spent an hour stuck on a small lift (elevator) in Estonia, all agreed that an overwhelming anointing had consistently accompanied the team throughout the trip.

Dijon, France

At the recent leaders' meeting in Dijon held from 13-15th March, 1998, a main topic was Voice magazine. In a close co-operative work between the French National Voice Team and International Publications in Europe, new ideas were introduced into the French edition of Voice for France. This first issue of the new project was laid-out in a multi-media presentation by French National Director René Agrain. International Publications Director, Blair Scott, shared his excitement and vision for this new project as well as for his teamwork with the French men.
