Central European Conference

“Catch the Fire” – August 27-29th

What a blessing it was attend the Conference held just outside of Budapest! In addition to those attending from Hungary, there were representatives from Bulgaria, Romania, Yugoslavia, the Czech Republic, Sweden, Norway, Germany, Austria, Ireland, Brazil, Ghana, Togo, and Italy. It was truly an international event. The freedom and joy in worship was wonderful, and God moved mightily to heal bodies and change lives.

Miklos Molnar (Hungarian National President) expressed the thanks of the Hungarian Fellowship to the other nations who have ministered in his country, helping to build the Fellowship there. He also prayed for a Bulgarian journalist, who will be presenting a copy of the Happiest People on Earth to the Prime Minister of her country.

Christoph Hagele (Germany) spoke to us about how in business, getting money was not enough. Jesus is the key to personal success and happiness. Every person is tremendously valuable to God and we should make him feel that way. We should always treat others as we would like to be treated.

Richard Maiden (U.S.A.) encouraged us to Catch the Fire so that we can bring deliverance and healing, setting people free from bondage. It's not enough to believe it in your head; you have to step out in faith and do something with it. We need to realize there is a fire of God. We must receive it, allowing God to burn away what needs to be burned from our lives, and then give that fire away. Just like in the days of Pentecost, we will change our world.

Justin Steinsland (Norway): We need to want to see revival – to have a great desire to see people coming to Christ. There needs to be a

“flow”, which goes from high pressure – *the love of Christ* – to low pressure – *the vacuum in the lives of the lost*. We need to get rid of our pride and go out. As we share the love of Christ with others, more will flow into our own hearts and lives.

Thomas Ocansey (Ghana) spoke about revival as “the ability to share”. “God can bring peace in the midst of turmoil,” he told us. Prayer works. In Ghana they have seen God do mighty miracles, including blind eyes being opened, and even the dead being raised. “Our tongue has been made to praise the Lord,” he warned, “And we need to be cautious that we don't share it with the devil by using words of complaint, accusation or murmuring.”

Wayne Scott (Canada): I prayed for a Christian woman, who was visibly burdened. Though forgiven of her sins and walking with the Lord, she still carried a load of guilt. She left after prayer totally free of all burdens, and praising the Lord.

Jack and Margaret o'Donoghue celebrated their 41st wedding anniversary during the convention. On a previous trip to Hungary, Jack was asked to pray for a woman who had been unable to conceive a child. This time he had the honour of praying for the child who was an answer to that prayer.

When I saw a cousin, I offered her two copies and she willing took them.

Over the next couple of days I gave the magazines to four more people. Before going to Thunder Bay, I read three different copies to refresh my Dutch. With some of my relatives I could speak only Dutch as they were very limited in the English language. Over the weekend I had some long talks with my aunt and cousins, especially about physical healing. My aunt
